



Green Lake County Hazardous Waste Clean Sweep August 13 & 14, 2010

What: A hazardous waste chemical collection program for residents of Green Lake County
REGISTRATION REQUIRED - deadline August 10, 2010

When: Friday, August 13, 2010 - 3 pm to 6 pm
and
Saturday, August 14, 2010 - 8 am to noon

Where: Green Lake County Highway Department (Fairgrounds)
570 South Street, Green Lake

Why: Provide a safe and environmentally responsible manner to dispose of unwanted lawn and garden pesticides, household cleaning products, poisons and chemicals.

What Can I Dispose of? Bring any products that say: caution, toxic, corrosive, poison, combustible, flammable, warning, danger, or reactive.

Unused, unwanted, expired prescription and over-the-counter medicines in original containers with medication name visible

DO NOT BRING

- Ammunition
- Appliances
- Biologicals
- Computers/Electronics
- Cylinders (propane)
- Explosives (dynamite, fireworks)
- Fire Extinguishers
- Latex Paint
- Medical Wastes
- Radioactives
- Tires
- Vehicle Batteries

What Should I Do with Unwanted Latex Paint?

- Latex Paint is not a hazardous material. It can be disposed of as a solid with your regular trash - leave the lids off.
 - If the paint is liquid, open the top of the can and allow the paint to air dry. To speed up the process, add sand, kitty litter, sawdust or a latex paint hardener (found at hardware/home improvement stores) to the paint.

Be Careful!

These products have warning labels on them for a reason. Before putting them in your vehicle, take the following precautions:

- Keep products in their original containers when possible.
 - Make sure products are properly sealed to prevent leaks and spills. If a container is leaking, put it into a secondary leak-proof container.
 - Do not mix products together. Dangerous reactions can occur when some chemicals are mixed.
 - Pack containers in sturdy boxes in the trunk of your vehicle, away from the driver, passengers and pets. Cardboard boxes work well, but containers (other than gasoline cans) and boxes cannot be returned to you.
 - Please do not put items in plastic bags.
 - If a product does not have the original label, label it yourself if you are certain of the contents. This will help to dispose of it properly.
 - Always store products in a secure place, away from children, pets, sparks and flames.
