Bid should indicate start date and length of project. Completion date should be not later than 30 days of start date. Bid is to include all state and local approvals, permits, and fees.

A Bid Bond of 5% shall accompany the bid. The County requires \$1,000,000 of liability insurance and certificate of workers compensation.

Specifications:

Bridge Dimensions	35' x 12'
Design Weight	14,000 lbs
Approaches	3/4 inch stone extending out between 12 and 15 feet long and 12 feet wide from each edge of the bridge. The ends of the bridge will sit on either treated wooden sills or on a metal plate that are 3' wide by 14' long, 6" thick.
Deck and Railing Materials	#2 southern yellow pine (.40 Ret.) acq treated arsenic-free to construct decking and railing for bridge.

Bid should include: Site preparation, cost of state and local approvals, permits and fees, Structural Material, Labor and Equipment Rental

All bids must follow the Bridge Guidelines as set for by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
