Agenda: Motion/second (Severson/Dolata) to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

**Minutes:** *Motion/second* (*Severson/Dolata*) to approve the May 13, 2014 meeting minutes with changes under Seneca-Warren – Sucker Creek/Lateral A, change ... in high water to all of the water is going around the structure. Motion carried.

**Public Comments:** *Motion/second (Severson/Dolata)* to extend the public comment limit from 3 minutes to whatever it takes. Motion carried.

Tom Guden stated that he is not in favor of the ditch spraying. Guden is concerned of drift from the spraying getting onto his property and killing his trees and garden. Guden does not have anything planted in the district corridor but is concerned beyond the corridor.

**Appearances:** Amber Converse, MSA, presented a power point on the new watershed assessment. It outlined the process for delineating the watershed, how the assessment will be based on soil hydrologic groups and the different data sets that were used for the assessment.

**Watershed Tax Assessment Update:** Board made decisions of no cut-off values and a blanket of \$3/parcel, treat the district corridor as neutral (land not assessed), use 25-yr 24-hr storm for the rain event (open channel design event), total collection amount of \$30,000/yr., and treat wetlands as equal now. Morris spoke with Gary Walejko, Chariman - Marion Drainage District, and he would like a board member to attend their August meeting to discuss the Watershed Assessment.

**Seneca-Warren Drainage District – Sucker Creek/Lateral A:** Board discussed dam placement. Discussion with MSA about the main ditch bottom from Hwy D to Lateral A. MSA will send map of the Sucker Creek watershed. Board will draft letter to DNR.

**Seneca-Warren Drainage District – Brush Cutting/Weed Spraying:** Email from Skyline Helicopters stating that the cost to do 5.7 miles of ditch would be \$5700.00. Chemical Aquatic Plant Control Application submitted to the DNR with \$195.00 application fee.

**Lehmann Shed Wetland Restoration:** Alf's will oppose at public meeting. No regard to board.
