October Projects

1. Meet with many Green Lake Watershed landowners to discuss their interest of installing BMP's on their property.
2. Monitor current erosion control permits throughout the county for compliance with county ordinances.
3. Create LCC virtual tour presentation and present to LCC Committee.
4. Create new COC's for Farmland Preservation participants that bought or sold land and require updated COC's.
5. Bid out several jobs that are due to be installed in spring of 2021.
6. Completed the design of a grassed diversion and subsurface drain in the Town of Manchester.
7. Organize all old erosion control permit folders and stormwater management plan folders and file accordingly.
8. Update and review NMP – 4 landowners
9. Designs for Grade Stabilization Structures – 2 separate landowners (BGL)
10. Assist Markesan School District with Grass Waterway design.
11. Certify Buffer Installation – Buffer Program
12. Webinar – Mandatory State Nutrient Management Programs
13. Assist Drainage Board with Annual Inspections.

November Project Focus

1. Complete the design of a grassed waterway and two farmable diversions in the Town of Manchester.
2. Complete the design of a grade stabilization structure, rock-lined waterway, and culvert protection in the Town of Green Lake.
3. Complete the design of a rock-lined waterway, 2 grassed waterways and a trash rack in the town of Green Lake.
4. Stakeout some projects for Green Lake Watershed landowners once their crops are off to get their input on placement and approval of BMP installation.
5. Assist the Town of Green Lake address an erosion issue that a lake resident is experiencing and come up with a design that will solve the problem.

Lake and River Report

Puckaway – Breakwater Design Permit Received. Preliminary DU Engineer approval. Received \$200,000 grant from DNR for partial project funding. . Lake District has approved funding.

Twin Lakes – No Updates.

Spring Lake – No updates.

Little Green – No Updates

Green Lake – Culvert replacement on Skunk Hollow and Maug Rd completed. Soil was spread on the site, and banks were seeded. Working with the township on road shoulders to meet the township's requirements for width and slope. Installed Grassed Waterway at Avalon Farms. Basin at Lenz Farm repairs completed (emergency spillway was damaged during storm event). Staking for fall/winter streambank repair underway.

Grand Lake – submitted DNR final grant application for 2021 tracer dye test (precursor to chemical treatment to determine flow rates and dilution rates)
